Confidentiality?

We will make sure no one can identify you. We will only break confidentiality if we feel you are at risk of harm to yourself or other.

Study Aims

This study wants to understand what works best for supporting LGBTQ+ young people with their mental health.

Consent?

Your parents will not be informed that you are involved in this study. You can consent yourself if you can show you understand what you are being asked to do.

What's involved?

You will be asked to be involved in a text interview using WhatsApp. Once it has been exported the WhatsApp chat will be deleted. We can pay for phone data to help you to take part.



Benefits?

You will be able to give your opinions and help us understand what LGBTQ+ young people want from a mental health service.

What do I say?

You will be asked about your experiences and thoughts on mental health services, NOT details about your mental health, sexual orientation or gender identity.

Risks?

For this study, we have processes in place to make sure if you become distressed or upset we can help. For example we might have to tell your case/support worker.
